BYOT-BRING YOUR OWN TECHNOLOGY

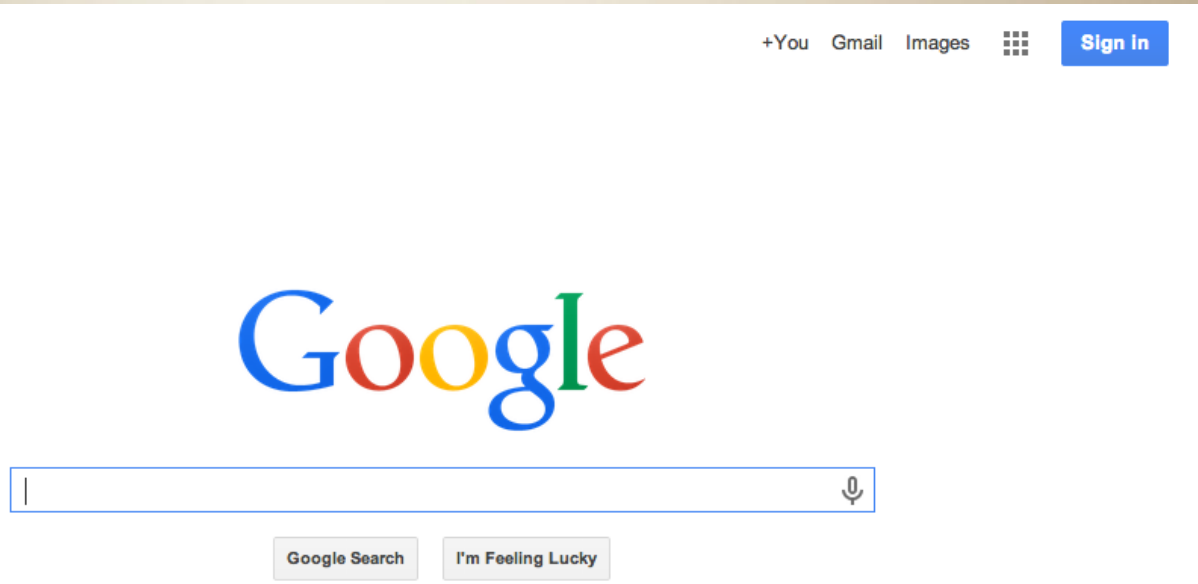
-In order to bring a technological device to school, we must have a signed contract.
